All about Exit Devices

Instructor: David Thielen, CML, CHI, CAI, has been a professional locksmith for over 40 years, working for local lock shops, over 30 years with Adams County Schools and recently Intermountain Lock Supply. Class Content: 60% Lecture/ 40% hands on

Class Limit: 30

This course will present a wealth of information on Standard and Fire Rated Exit Devices. Types, applications, functions, ratings, options, installation, electrical options, repairs and servicing will be discussed. Twenty various exit devices will be available for the hands on portion. Students will be able to troubleshoot, identify, test and investigate the various devices. A section on delayed exit devices and code issues will be addressed. Upon completion of this class, the student will be able to properly remove, retrofit, service and troubleshoot malfunctions of many of the popular exit devices. Information presented will aid in preparing for the PRP L16 section on Exit devices.
