Presidents Notes:

This newsletter should be in your hands before the end of August. The October class will be a Lishi tools workshop, specifically for the new KW1, SC1, SC4 and KW5 tools. After some discussion, it was decided to separate the fee for participating in the workshop from the cost of purchasing the tools. We will buy enough tools for use during the workshop and / or sale to participants. All tools will be Original Lishi, and we will pass along any discount we can get, from an authorized distributor. We are aware that the designs have already been copied, and will not compromise on quality by buying knock-offs.

To keep the class affordable, we chose not to bundle the cost of a tool into the class fee. This will also allow you to specify which tool or tools you want. If you already own one or more of these tools, you may want to add to your set. Any unsold Lishi tools will be available at the January or subsequent meetings.

In January, we are planning an ALOA class and sponsoring a sitting for the PRP exam. A request has been submitted to ALOA and I have signed and returned the agreement. It is essential to register for this, at least 30 days in advance.

Current Nebraska Fire Codes

- The State Fire Marshal's Office currently uses the 2000 edition of NFPA 101 and associated NFPA codes such as NFPA 80. We are in the process of updating our codes to the 2012 edition of NFPA 101 and 2010 edition of NFPA 80 so I would recommend looking at both when designing new installations. Local jurisdictions can use other codes in addition to our state fire codes, but our code is the minimum throughout the state.
- NFPA 101 has some new allowances in Chapter 7 for means of egress such as lock-ups and electronic door locking in addition to door inspection. They are worth a look
- Plan review should be conducted whenever a change could affect egress or the use of the building changes. A relevant example is the addition of electronic locks to doors in a means of egress. Inspections will follow plan reviews, but can be requested at any time.
- This is where the 'depends' comes in. many occupancies have differing requirements for locking such as health care vs. business vs. detention. Fail safe is almost always the baseline for our code.
- The newer editions of NFPA 80 contain requirements for door inspections. NFPA 101 mandates compliance with this requirement. While not enforced for most occupancies, it is a requirement for health care occupancies currently.

I provided an example:

"I'm working on a proposal for a church, to add magnetic locks on one entrance and electric latch retraction on another. The concern is safety of staff when there is only one person in the office. The objective is to allow entry with valid credentials or manual release of magnetic lock from the office. Motion detector would release the magnet, allowing anyone to exit. Fire alarm or request-to-exit button would also release."

Response:

- The example you give appears to be access-controlled locking. Section 7.2.1.6.2 lists the requirements and it appears you may meet those requirements in your description.
