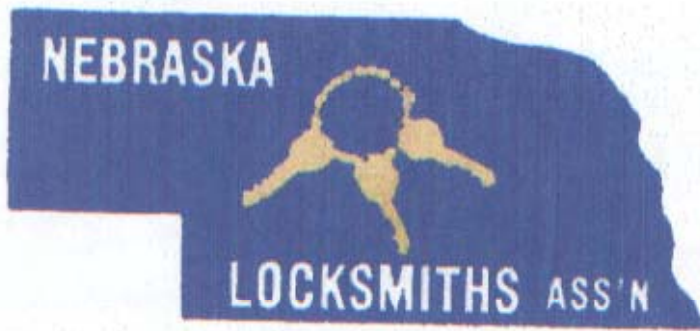

New Business: Dale Voigt was voted on to continue as Secretary. Also, Tony Delgado was voted on to continue as Treasurer.

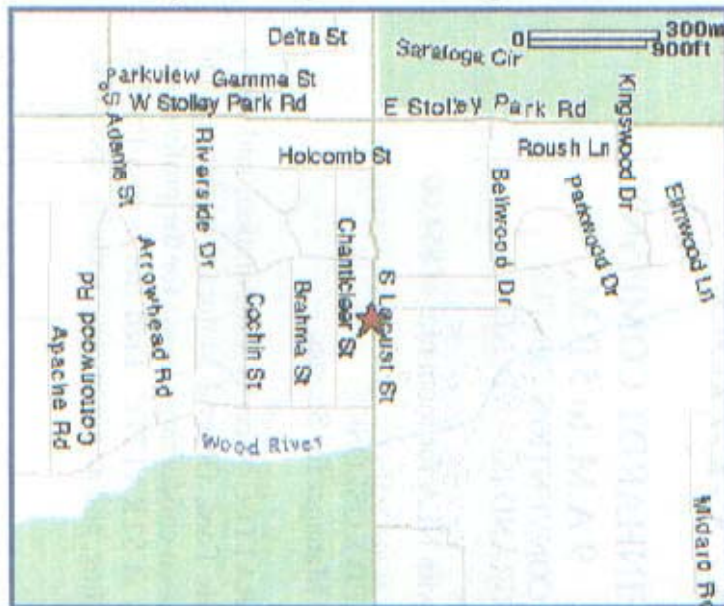
It was brought up about why the officers were not getting the newsletter in the mail as they were promised. Someone said they would talk to Paula again.
