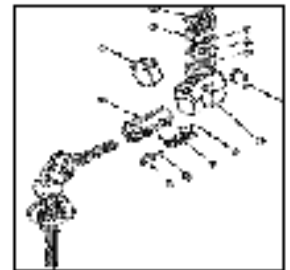

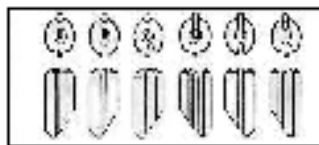

Design, construction, operation and distribution will be covered thoroughly. Students will recognize the difference between "high security" and "key control", as well as understand patent information and how to correctly service the North American high security cylinders. **Prerequisite:** The student should have a sound understanding and experience combining and master keying conventional cylinders (Basic pinning of a cylinder from a TMK and CK bittings required). The lab fee is for the Student Manual (a 53-page assemblage) that is confidential and proprietary information specifically compiled to be used in class and which the student will retain afterwards. **PRP:** ALOA members who pay the additional fee of \$35.00 for the test may take PRP Section L-08 at the end of the class.
